This ancient Indian scripture addresses death and the dimensions that lie beyond it. It is set against the background of story about a young boy Nachiketās and his search for the secret of death, life and inner mystery, by confronting Lord Yama (Lord of Death). The student asks, "Is there any existence beyond death"? The master answers the question couched with mystical symbolism and guides the student step by step to the glorious state of immortality, peace and bliss.

*Kathopaniṣad* was translated into Persian in 17th century, and then translated into Latin and circulated across Europe.

This teaching is the most remarkable mystical revelation on liberation and self - mastery on the spiritual path.
