

-Travel with us on a spiritual journey, where you will experience the culture and traditions of ancient cities and villages in the foothills of the Himalayas.

- -Our trip will take us to bustling small towns, deep valleys hemmed with forests, dotted with temples, with rustic views of the Garhwal Himalayan mountains.
- -Experience the simple village folk and meet renunciate monks steeped in devotion. We will start our trip from a modern palace hotel in New Delhi and fly to Dehradun on our way to Haridwar, one of the holiest places in India. Here you will see the hustle and bustle of people, with narrow lane bazaars, enjoy unmatched views of the Ganga river, visit ancient shrines and attend the famous Ganga arati.
- -In Rishikesh, we will stay at a modern ayurvedic retreat Center, visit ashrams, participate in a Hindu ritual and take a dip in the holy river Ganga.
- -In Uttarkashi, we explore the simplicity of the village folk, visit ancient temples including the famous Kashi Vishwanath Temple dedicated to Lord Shiva, take a trek through the village, meet monks and local dwellers, and chant hymns to Mother Ganga by the bank of the river.
- -Weather permitting, a day sojourn to Gangotri, nestled among lofty Garhwal Himalayan peaks, glaciers and dense forests. Gangotri is one of highest pilgrimages in India (approx. 3,415 m).
- -In Dev Prayag, we will enjoy the awesome sight of the confluence of the sacred Alaknanda and Bhagirathi rivers merging to form the holy Ganga river.

DAY 1: Arrival Delhi - airport pick up, drive to hotel, welcome dinner and rest - 1 night

DAY 2 to 3: Fly to Dehradun & Drive to Haridwar - temple visits and Ganga arati - 2 nights

DAY 4 to 6: Drive to Rishikesh - temple and Ashram visits, Ganga Arati. Dip in the holy river - 3 nights

DAY 7 to 12: Drive to Uttarkashi. Ancient temple visits, chanting of Ganga hymn on the bank of the holy river. Trekking. Day trip to Gangotri (weather permitting) - 5 nights

DAY 13 to 15: Drive to Dev Prayag (near Rishikesh). Rejuvenate and absorb the vibes of the confluence of two sacred rivers - 4 nights

DAY 16: Drive to Dehradun & fly to Delhi. Trip concludes

Trip ends with flight back to Delhi airport. No hotel stay in Delhi included.

Accommodation/hotel can be arranged at expense of the traveler - as some may fly out same night.

Trip Includes:

- All accommodation on twin sharing basis (except October 2)
- Airport transfers in Delhi on arrival and departure.
- All meals provided. Only Vegetarian: no non-veg., eggs, fish, meat or alcohol is permitted on the trip
- Round Trip **flight** Delhi Dehradun and comfortable **Innova Crysta cars for all road travel.**
- Vedanta text for the teaching.
- Transport costs/sightseeing costs/entry tickets where applicable.
- All tips to drivers, porters etc.
- Special Puja

Offerings in temples by each individual are not included and are optional.

- At the end of the trip it is customary for all students to make an offering to the Teacher as Guru Dakshina for the Vedanta Teachings received during the entire trip.
- Participants registering are encouraged to take a travel insurance so that in case they have to cancel, they can request for a refund from the insurance company.
